Banking and financial system

Milan is the site of the main Italian banking groups (198 institutes) and more than forty foreign banks, occupying fourth position in Europe in terms of capitalisation. ABI (Italian Banking Association) represents the financial and banking system, both in Italy and abroad, protecting and promoting its interests.

The city also plays host to the Italian Stock Exchange (225 listed companies).


Fashion and design

Milan's economy is powered by its advanced tertiary sectors e.g. fashion and design. In the fashion sector, there are some 12,000 companies, 800 showrooms, 6,000 sales outlets, with four weeks dedicated to this activity, comprising fashion shows and complementary events.



University system

Milan's higher education system comprises 11 University centres (44 faculties, 174,000 new students a year, equal to 10% of the entire Italian university population).



Culture

Milan offers a rich cultural programme including: Sforzesco Castle, Convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie with The Last Supper (one of the world's most famous paintings), Archaeology Museum, Natural History Museum; the Brera Art Gallery, Ambrosiana Art Gallery, Poldi Pezzoli, Triennale and PAC (Contemporary art pavilion), which promotes a range of extensive and in-depth exhibition projects.








MOBILITY DENSITY FLOW

A jump into the future

Car sharing is a crucial element of multimodality and contributes to reducing the negative impacts of car traffic such as pollution, waste of energy and misuse of urban space. Especially for a city like **Milan** which has one of the most high ratio car/inhabitant of Europe: **56 cars every 100 inhabitants** (London 31, Berlin 29, Paris 25).

That's why **Milan** is strongly committed to **boosting such innovative sharing system**, in line with the directives of the Transport White Paper prepared by the European Commission, which calls on Member States to halve the use of 'conventionally-fuelled' cars in urban transport by 2030 and phase them out in cities by 2050.

GuidaMi: The Service

- GuidaMi offers 130 cars to 7.500 subscribers, 80 parking areas (65% of the people living within the “Cerchia 90-91” area is only 5 minutes on foot from a car sharing station)
- Open 24h/7days
- Car sharing services in Milano and in some surrounding municipalities (Sesto S. Giovanni, Monza, Bollate)
- A service in Network with similar systems in Bologna, Brescia, Firenze, Genova, Padova, Palermo, Parma, Roma, Torino, Venezia (Network ICS “Io Guido Car Sharing”)

CAR SHARING SCENARIO IN MILAN

The literature accounts between **1% and 3%** the traditional car-sharing users penetration rate. An extra quota between 0,4 and 1,5% of daily city users has been considered proper to add to the analysis.

Applying these indexes, it has been estimated a car sharing development between **16,100** and **53,300** of car sharing's potential users in Milan.

To serve such potential demand of car-sharing users, considering 1 vehicle every 25 users, an offer between **600** and **2100 vehicles** has been estimated as adequate to Milan.

Public Notice

Following this study, the Municipality of Milan launched in June 2013 a **Public Notice** for "Expression of Interest for the identification of stakeholders to carry out the car-sharing services on the territory of the Municipality of Milan".

This notice was addressed at fulfilling the following main requirements:

- ✓ **One way system**
- ✓ **"Fast" Reservation**
- ✓ **Fleet with at least 80 vehicles falling within the categories of electric, hybrid, natural gas, LPG, gasoline, EURO 5 and later, diesel approved under Directive 70/220/EEC and adequate levels of security by the European program EURONCAP**
- ✓ **90% of the fleet with a length less than 4.50 m**
- ✓ **At least one vehicle out of 100 fitted for the transport of persons with reduced mobility**

Car2go is a subsidiary of Daimler AG providing carsharing services in European and North American cities. The company offers exclusively Smart Fortwo vehicles and features one-way point-to-point rentals.

Users are charged by the minute, with hourly and daily rates available.

The service runs via a downloadable smartphone app.

There are currently **798 vehicles authorized by the Administration to circulate on streets.**

ENJOY

Enjoy is a car sharing service provided by ENI in partnership with Fiat and Trenitalia. The company offers FIAT 500 vehicles and features one-way point-to-point rentals.

Users are charged by the minute, with hourly and daily rates available.

The service runs via a downloadable smartphone app: a revolutionary App which has removed the need for the paperwork-based process of other car-sharing services. Before Enjoy, infact, these systems required a card to open the car.

There are currently **644 vehicles authorized by the Administration to circulate on streets.**

Twist is the latest car sharing operator in Milan. The company offers Volkswagen Up vehicles and features one-way point-to-point rentals.

Users are charged by the minute, with hourly and daily rates available.

The service runs via a downloadable smartphone app.

There are currently **80 vehicles** circulating on streets but soon will be **500 vehicles in total authorized by the Administration**.

MOBILITY CHALLENGES – EQ SHARING


The City of Milan puts into effect an innovative system of sharing mobility, named “**EQ Sharing**”, the first **totally electric car sharing** service in Milan, with the aim of improving and simplifying services to citizens, progressing towards a smart cities model.

The project is an **integrated service** of sustainable mobility, consisting of electric quadricycles, with which Milan expands its range of innovative mobility services. Halfway between the services of bike sharing and car-sharing, the new service will allow the citizens and city users to move **freely and H24**.

There are currently **120 quadricycles** circulating on streets.

EQ Sharing is practical and easy, and well connected with public transport because all Digital Areas are placed **near main transport junctions**.

Digital Island is a wider project that encompasses EQ Sharing system. The whole system has:

- **8 slots for public electric quadricycles**
- **4 recharging site for private electric quadricycles**

Equipped with::

- **Wi Fi**
- **Multimedia and multifunction touch-screen Totem (services: infomobility, taxi and emergency calls, bookings, e-commerce, e-government, tourism)**
- **NFC technology**
- **Smart cameras for territory monitoring and control**
- **Smart lighting**
- **Recharging systems for private users (computer, phones, etc.)ecc.)**
- **Recharging systems for public electric vehicles**
- **Recharging systems for private electric vehicles**


